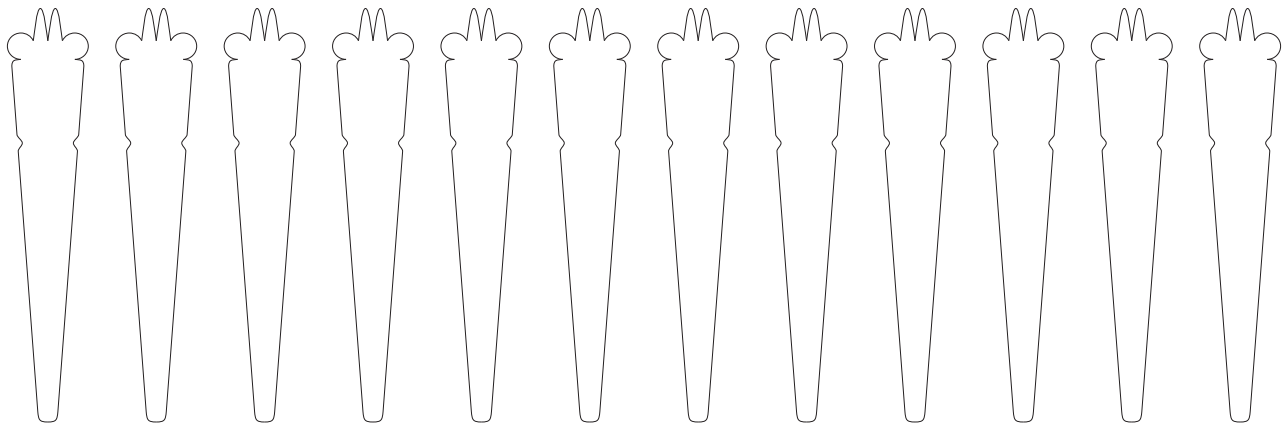


Stack cut wings in a multiple of 2 (2, 4 or 6) from 1/8" stock. Cut out the wings using #1 to #5 blade. Sand edge of wings to 30 degrees using a belt sander; half the wings pointing one way, the other half pointing the opposite. *Note you need only one pattern for each set of butterflies. The other pattern is reversed in case it fits the wood better.*

Cut out body from 1/4" wood. Glue wings on each side of the body at thorax bulge. Glue 1/2" rare-earth magnet on bottom of body.
